

- E. Can we have monthly number of new discoveries of sensitive sites from BLM?
 - F. Dave Vlcek will take a couple of posters to the next archeologist meeting in St. Louis and try a outreach program. Posters will say come out and dig and research. He will take posters to other meetings.
 - G. BLM has a backlog and last year they had a seasonal archeologist technician come on board and a lot of backlog was cleaned up. Recommend to PAWG that BLM get another seasonal technician again to continue to work on backlog and other assignments to free up permanent BLM archeologist so they can do their job that they were hired to do.
 - H. Can we get some of the sensitive site materials displayed in the Pinedale area, by getting them from the universities that have them and loan them back for a rotating display?
 - I. Data sensitive report is a BLM job but the priority is low .but it is a mandate that should be recommend to PAWG to try to get this done by BLM.
 - J. Power line there are no sensitive sites that are impacted except by visual impact. Might consider private land objection.
 - K. Have PAWG continue to push for more education of various sensitive sites in area and how valuable they are to the Pinedale community. Along this line there has been a archeologist society established in the area.
5. Recommend to PAWG at next meeting.
- A. Mitigate a directive to have BLM monitor a list of prioritized sensitive sites twice a year.
 - B. Do a study of effect power line has on Lander Trail.
6. Boulder Landscape Plan
- A. There are two good elements ,it preserves Lander Trail view shed and proposes a back country scenic byway.
 - B. Long term planning allow renewal grazing permits without challenging.
