

**Pinedale Anticline Working Group**  
**Air Quality Task Group**

Meeting Notes  
Thursday April 30, 2009

The Air Quality Task Group, (AQTG), convened at the BLM office in Pinedale for a brief call-in meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to welcome new members to the AQTG, discuss the appointment of a new chairperson, and to decide how, or if to move forward with the recommendations from the most recent AQTG report to the PAWG, (2005 AQTG Report, and submitted 5/12/06).

- There was consensus that the 2005 AQTG Report was probably outdated and that the recommendations outlined in that report should be reconsidered and tabled for the time being.
- The Task Group agreed to look at the old report and make edits or suggestions on what the document needs, to reflect the current state of affairs on the Pinedale Anticline, and to support new recommendations to the PAWG.
