Since the majority of Area A falls within Rock Springs Field Office, coordination was done between both offices to determine LWC for Area A. Rock Springs Field Office determined the Desolation Road (ROWs covered by lease unit and County Road) that bisects the area south of the checkerboard and north of the WSA boundary road, as well as the road three miles east of that parallels the field office boundary. For the Rawlins Field Office side, an improved road heads north off the Adobe Town Road in T 16 R95 Section 31 (covered by ROWs WYW-123029, WYW-15839, & WYW-157684) into the checkerboard land pattern. Since these roads bi-sect Area A, the area does not meet the size criteria.
