Mexican Grave Outlier 1: The unit is bound on the west by a developed oilfield access road and on the east by a series of oilfield access roads and developed pipeline rights-of-way.

Mexican Grave Outlier 2: The unit is bound by the following constraints: 1) on the west by a developed oilfield access road; 2) on the north by a developed pipeline right-of-way; and 3) on east by a developed pipeline right-of-way.

Mexican Grave Outlier 3: The unit is bound by the following constraints: 1) on the north by a series of developed pipeline rights-of-way and land owned by the State of Wyoming; 2) on the east by a series of developed oil field access roads and developed pipeline rights-of-way; 3) on the south by land owned by the State of Wyoming, a developed oil field access road, and BLM Road 3317, a.k.a. Windmill Draw Road; and 4) on the west by a series of developed oilfield access roads and developed pipeline rights-of-way.
