Dear Reader:

Natrona County filed right-of-way application WYW94433 for an access road on Federal land managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). An environmental assessment (EA) for the Archery Range Road has been completed by BLM. EA No. WY-060-EA09-83 addresses use and upgrading of an access road to Natrona County's Archery Range located on Casper Mountain.

The access road extends from a junction with Micro Road (Natrona County Road #504) in a south and southwesterly direction crossing a mix of Federal and private lands, including lands leased by and conveyed to the Wyoming Girl Scout Council under the Recreation and Public Purposes Act.

The BLM is providing a 30-day comment period prior to signing a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and Decision Record. Comments that clearly articulate site specific issues or concerns, and those received prior to the close of the comment period, are most useful to us and will be considered prior to publication of the Decision Record.

All comments, including names and addresses, will be available for public review. Individual respondents may request confidentiality. If you wish to withhold your name and/or address from public review or from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act, you must state this prominently at the beginning of your written comment. Such requests will be honored to the extent allowed by law. All submissions by businesses or organizations, and from individuals identifying themselves as representatives or officials of businesses or organizations, will be made available for inspection in their entirety.
