Dear Reader:

The Bureau of Land Management has completed an environmental assessment (EA) for the Greencore Carbon Dioxide Pipeline Project. Greencore Pipeline Company, LLC filed right-of-way application WYW178752 for a 231.1 mile 20-inch carbon dioxide transportation pipeline on Federal land managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). An environmental assessment (EA) for the Greencore Pipeline has been completed by BLM. EA No. WY-060-EA11-32 addresses the installation and use of a carbon dioxide pipeline to serve the Bell Creek Oilfield in Montana.

The pipeline extends from the Conoco Phillips Lost Cabin Gas Plant in Fremont County in a southeasterly direction crossing a mix of Federal, State of Wyoming, and private lands toward Natrona, Wyoming. From there it heads in a northeastern direction crossing a comparable mix of lands, to the Bell Creek Oilfield in Powder River County, Montana.

The BLM is providing a 30-day comment period prior to signing a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and Decision Record. Comments that clearly articulate site specific issues or concerns, and those received prior to the close of the comment period will be evaluated for consideration prior to publication of the Decision Record.

All comments, including names and addresses, will be available for public review. Individual respondents may request confidentiality. If you wish to withhold your name and/or address from public review or from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act, you must state this prominently at the beginning of your written comment. Such requests will be honored to the extent allowed by law. All submissions by businesses or organizations, and from individuals identifying themselves as representatives or officials of businesses or organizations, will be made available for inspection in their entirety.
