The Decision Record and Finding of No Significant Impact (DR/FONSI), is now complete for the Bill Barrett Corporation, Red Point 3-D Seismic Exploration project. The document can be reviewed at the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Cody Field Office, or at the following websites:

The location of the seismic exploration is approximately 22 miles east of Cody, Wyoming, near U.S. Highway 14-16-20 in the McCullough Peaks Wild Horse Herd Management Area.

A decision has been made to authorize the proposed action with project design features as part of the proposed action. Some changes to the project design features and monitoring plan were made as a result of public comment. The project design features along with monitoring and standard stipulations has resulted in a FONSI; no environmental impact statement will be prepared.

This Environmental Assessment and subsequent DR/FONSI were prepared pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act and other relevant laws and regulations, to fully disclose the anticipated impacts of the proposed action.
