



Energy Gateway South Transmission Project BLM Identifies a Preliminary Agency Preferred Route

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is announcing the **preliminary** agency preferred route for the Energy Gateway South Transmission Project. The project, proposed by PacifiCorp (doing business as Rocky Mountain Power), is a 500-kilovolt, long-distance power transmission line from southeastern Wyoming to central Utah.

The BLM and cooperating agencies are analyzing the **preliminary** agency preferred route and the alternative routes in the draft environmental impact statement, which will be released in February 2014.
