

Proposed Intermountain Transmission Projects



Boardman to Hemingway

- Idaho Power
- 500-kilovolt (kV) alternating current transmission line (approximately 300 miles)

Energy Gateway West Transmission Project

- Idaho Power and Rocky Mountain Power
- 500kV and 230kV alternating current transmission lines (approximately 1,000 miles)
- Record of Decision issued in November 2013

Energy Gateway South Transmission Project

- Rocky Mountain Power
- 500kV alternating current transmission line
- 400+ miles long
- Environmental Impact Statement is being prepared
- Alternative routes affect 16 counties in Wyoming, Colorado, and Utah

Southwest Intertie Project (SWIP) North

- Great Basin Transmission, LLC
- 500kV alternating current transmission line (approximately 260 miles)

TransWest Express Transmission Project

- TransWest Express, LLC
- 600kV direct current or alternating current transmission line (approximately 725 miles)

Southern Nevada Intertie Project (SNIP)

- Great Basin Transmission, LLC
- 500kV alternating current transmission line (approximately 60 miles)
