Dear Reader:

The Bureau of Land Management Lander Field Office is issuing the Decision Record for the Double D Ranch Wild Horse Ecosanctuary. This decision selects the BLM Preferred Alternative which authorizes Double D Ranch to pasture 100 wild horses gathered primarily from Wyoming public rangelands. After a period of satisfactory monitoring and compliance, the BLM has the option of increasing the number of wild horses to be cared for in the ecosanctuary. Public lands are not included in the ecosanctuary.

All comments received during the 21-day public review period for the Environmental Assessment (EA-050-14-07) have been considered. This Decision Record, along with the EA, Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) and response to comments are available on the internet at:
