 As an active member of the oil and gas service community in Denver, Colorado, for the past 28 years, I am writing to you today to express my strong support for increased domestic natural gas development in the Pinedale Anticline area of Sublette County, Wyoming. Allowing for limited, year-round access, as the DSEIS call for, will have a positive impact on the local and regional economy. It will spur strong economic growth as it will create a more stable (and a safety conscious) workforce, provide a significant tax source for local communities while significantly supporting Wyoming's business and academic communities. Our company employs 20 people from the Evanston area with about fifty percent of our tool inventory provided for the operators who drill in the Anticline area.
