
W-1 I write to urge you to take every action necessary to preserve the Greater Sage Grouse
I-41-1 and its habitat. Please adopt the stipulations developed by Audubon Wyoming for this

During the 60's I lived in Cody. We always looked forward to our trips around the State, eager to see the wildlife. Later I lived in Kalispell Montana – would drive up through Thermopolis and Yellowstone – and back through the Tetons and Pinedale. Truthfully, I'm afraid to take that trip again. It was not until last spring that I actually saw sage grouse on the lek. Took a trip over to Gunnison and was rewarded with a grand display.

The oil and gas lying beneath the surface of the sage steppes will always be there. Please make sure that the wildlife will be there as well. If that means no drilling, so be it. Here in western Colorado we are facing the same challenges, especially Garfield County.

Be an example of stewardship. There are many who came before you who will applaud a decision to protect our wildlife.
