Dear Governor Freudenthal and Matt Anderson,

Having been residents of Wyoming for 18 years before having to move for health concerns, we are not unacquainted with the state. Our hearts will always be in Wyoming, but we greatly fear the Wyoming we knew no longer exists. We hate to see 4,400 *additional* natural gas wells in the Pinedale Anitcline, disturbing 12,272 acres, on top of a plan to add 3,100 new wells to the Jonah Field! Is Wyoming to be sacrificed to the extractive industries? And, CBMs are littering the land and polluting water.

As to the Pinedale Anticline Natural Gas Field in the Upper Green River Valley, we would like to suggest that development outside of the core area be precluded to provide wildlife a haven, that you hold industry accountable for its practices, that you enforce a limit to emissions and protect air quality and human health from gas-field pollution. We would also like to see well-defined and binding mitigation requirements, including reclamation. In addition, we feel you should adopt all the components of the Wyoming Game & Fish Department's *Minimum* Recommendations report, establishing practices allowing for oil & gas development while protecting wildlife.

Please do not allow further degradation of Wyoming that we see now occurring.
