Dear PAPA RDSEIS Project Manager:

I urge the Bureau of Land Management to adopt a plan that safely and effectively allows more efficient utilization of natural gas to occur in Wyoming's Pinedale Anticline Project Area.

U.S. federal policies have mandated increased use of clean burning natural gas while simultaneously limiting access to domestic supplies, making it necessary that we allow reasonable access to Pinedale's world-class resource of clean-burning natural gas.

According to the U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM), the Pinedale Anticline contains an estimated 21 trillion cubic feet of natural gas reserves, making it the second largest gas field in the United States. Access to these important natural resources can help address the nation's energy challenge and relieve the burden placed on business and consumers.

With today's technology, year-round access to these resources can be conducted in an environmentally responsible manner. Access to natural gas in the Pinedale Anticline will balance resources and benefit the community through the industry proposal to voluntarily reduce emissions and human activity, conserve wildlife and habitat and help with community planning.
