

| M-1/MO-1 |  | FL-2-8  |  | Development of wildlife monitoring and mitigation plan IN THE FINAL SEIS, not later                 |
| W-3      |  | FL-2-9  |  | When excessive impacts to wildlife occur, pace of development must be slowed                        |
| M-2      |  | FL-2-10 |  | ALL off-site mitigation dollars to be paid in at beginning of project, not tied to development pace |
| LS-2     |  | FL-2-11 |  | All currently unleased areas and expired leases be withdrawn from leasing for the life of the SEIS  |
