

**Notice of Availability  
Atlantic Rim Catalina PODs G&I  
Coalbed Natural Gas Development  
Carbon County, Wyoming**

**SUMMARY:** The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Rawlins Field Office has received a proposal for a 51 well coal bed natural gas development within the Atlantic Rim Natural Gas Development project area. The project, entitled "Catalina POD G&I" is 4,241 acres in extent and is proposed by Double Eagle Petroleum Corporation. An environmental assessment (EA) and Finding of No New Significant Impact (FONNSI) for the Catalina POD G&I has been prepared and is available for public review and comment. **SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:** The BLM, Rawlins Field Office, Rawlins, Wyoming, has made available for public comment an EA for a proposal to build a 51 well coalbed natural gas development within the boundaries of the Atlantic Rim Natural Gas Development Project. The project area includes crucial year round winter ranges for antelope and mule deer and involves the construction of well pads, roads, utilities and ancillary facilities on State of Wyoming, private property, and the National System of Public Lands. The public, Agency, Tribal and interested organizations are invited to review the document and comment in writing. The BLM will use substantive comments to correct, modify or affirm the EA and FONSI prior to issuing a Decision Record in the matter.
