

Chokecherry and Sierra Madre Wind Energy Project

Bureau of Land Management and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Coordination

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) is preparing an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) on Power Company of Wyoming's application for an Eagle Take Permit for Phase I Wind Turbine Development for the Chokecherry and Sierra Madre Wind Energy Project (CCSM). The USFWS and Bureau of Land Management (BLM) National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) processes will take place concurrently. The BLM and USFWS will coordinate throughout their individual NEPA processes as cooperators.
