The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Rawlins and Rock Springs Field Offices have prepared an Environmental Analysis (EA) for gathering of excess wild horses within the Adobe Town and Salt Wells Creek Wild Horse Herd Management Areas (Adobe Town - Salt Wells Creek Herd Management Complex (ATSW Complex)) and wild horses which have strayed to areas outside of these HMAs.
