The Bureau of Land Management's Rock Springs Field Office has launched a 30-day public comment period for environmental assessment *2014 Removal of Wild Horses from Checkerboard within the Great Divide Basin, Salt Wells Creek and Adobe Town Herd Management Areas WY-040-EA15-104*. On March 3, 2015, United States District Court for the District of Wyoming, Case No. 14-CV-0152-NDF, remanded the BLM actions under NEPA back to the BLM to remedy.
