Written comments, including the names and addresses of respondents, will be available for public review at the BLM, RSFO during regular business hours (7:45 - 4:30 P.M.), Monday through Friday (except Federal holidays). After the comment period closes, comments may be published as part of the environmental process. Individual respondents may request confidentiality. If you wish to withhold your name and/or address from public review or from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act, you must state this prominently at the beginning of your written comment. Such requests will be honored to the extent allowed by law. All submissions from organizations or businesses, and from individuals identifying themselves as representatives or officials or organizations or businesses, will be made available for public inspection in their entirety.
