The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Rock Springs Field Office (RSFO) will be preparing an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the "Puma Prospect." Davis Petroleum Corp has indicated their intent to further drill and develop gas resources in the BLM Rock Springs Field Office within Sweetwater County, Wyoming. The project area is located throughout multiple sections within Tps. 14 and 15 N., Rs. 111 and 112 W., 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian.

The enclosed document serves as notice of the beginning of the environmental analysis process to fulfill the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act. The 30-day scoping period will begin on May 21, 2008, and end on June 19, 2008. 
