The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Rock Springs Field Office is releasing for 30-day public review the White Mountain/Little Colorado (WMLC) Herd Management Areas Wild Horse Gather Environmental Assessment (EA), WY-040-EA11-124. The comment period runs from April 7, 2011 until May 6, 2011. The proposed WMLC Gather could commence as early as July 2011, or when federal funding allows.

The EA describes four different alternatives, the affected environment, and consequences for each alternative. A decision on which alternative to implement will be made after the public review period. Your comments are important and will be considered in the environmental analysis process. All comments in any of the aforementioned formats must be received by the Rock Springs Field Office by **May 6, 2011**, to be considered.

Please note that public comments submitted for this public review, including names, e-mail addresses, and street addresses of the respondents will be available for public review by appointment at the Rock Springs Field Office during regular business hours (7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.), Monday through Friday, except holidays.

Public comments are most helpful if the comments are specific. The regulations (40 CFR 1503.36) state that "comments on a proposed action shall be as specific as possible and may address either the adequacy of the statement or the merits of the alternatives discussed or both." The most valuable comments are those that cite specific actions or impacts in the document and offer informed analysis of what is presented.

The Scoping Letter for this proposed action was mailed on April 9, 2010, and the EA was posted on the internet on April 7, 2011. The public comments received during the scoping period have been incorporated into the EA and are made a part of this administrative record. Additional comments received during the public review period will be considered.
