The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Rock Springs Field Office released the Environmental Assessment (EA) for gathering excess wild horses within the White Mountain and Little Colorado Wild Horse Herd Management Areas on September 24, 2007. This is to notify you that the BLM has prepared a Decision Record and Finding of No Significant Impact implementing Alternative A: Remove Excess Animals (Lower Limit of AML range); Implement Two-Year Fertility Control Protocol.
