Dear Interested Party,

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Worland Field Office announces the availability of an Environmental Assessment (EA) for a proposed land sale near Ten Sleep, Wyoming.

The town of Ten Sleep proposes to purchase approximately 23 acres of public land, located about one mile southeast of town, to fill the affordable housing needs of the area. The town proposes to subdivide the lands into single acre lots and to provide water, utilities and streets to each lot. The lots would be sold to people willing to establish a permanent residence and construct a single family dwelling within a prescribed amount of time.

The EA has been prepared to analyze the impacts of the proposed project. It is available for public review and comment by visiting the BLM website at:
