



Student Career Experience Program (SCEP) Wyoming Bureau of Land Management

The Wyoming Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is actively involved in the Student Career Experience Program (SCEP).

Who?

- Students enrolled in accredited college, university, technical or vocational school with at least a half-time course load (9 credits undergraduate, 6 credit for graduate).
- Students in good academic standing, with a 2.5 grade point average or higher.
- Students who will be US citizens upon graduation from school.

What Jobs are Available? Students work in BLM positions that most closely match their academic majors. Below are some of the SCEP positions Wyoming BLM is recruiting for.

Petroleum Engineers and Technicians
Range Management Specialists
Archeologists
Procurement Specialists

Natural Resource Specialists
Wildlife Biologists
Cadastral Surveyors
Geologists

BLM provides to SCEPs:

- Up to twelve weeks of regular salary per year (average \$12 per hour).
- Travel to and from the duty station (does not include lodging, per diem or PCS moves)
- Expenses to mandatory SCEP Orientation for newly hired SCEP students and their Mentors
- Yearly tuition assistance (up to \$2,000 in-state, and \$3,000 out-of-state)

What commitments must the SCEP student make?

- To work full time (40 hours per week) for a period of 12 weeks per year and complete assigned duties.
- Provide BLM with copies of official transcript each semester/quarter.
- Maintain 2.5 or higher GPA and be in good standing with his/her academic institution.
- Provide official transcript with degree and/or certificate upon completion of academic program.
- Notify BLM of any changes to or interruptions in academic field of study.

Why be a SCEP?

- Students gain professional experience for a competitive salary.
- Students are eligible to receive the same benefits as full-time Federal employees, including health insurance, life insurance, accrued and holiday leave.
- Students who successfully complete the program are eligible for non-competitive conversion into full-time employment positions with the BLM.
