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Dear Ms Weaver:

This letter is an expression of interest to nominate lands for the Oil and Gas lease auction in Wyoming.

The lands are located as follows:

Washakie County, T45N – R88W, South ½ of section 25, South ½ of section 26, all of section 35. Total 1280 acres m/l.
These lands are BLM Surface and Minerals.

These above lands directly adjoin BLM lands to the North that are presently leased for oil and gas. Also I hold the State of Wyoming oil and gas lease directly south all of section 35, T45N – R88W. I am aware that the Big Horn Basin RMP is still in the development process. However I believe that these lands should be nominated without the new RMP in place, because of the existing oil and leases in place that adjoin the parcels to be nominated. These lands also will fall into the drainage area of the geologic structure to be developed for oil and gas production.

Are these above lands available for oil and gas leasing without the competitive bid process?
