Re: Continued Expression of Interest (EOI) in Federal Tracts: WY-1302-068 and WY-1302-069 for nomination in the BLM next available Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale (August 2, 2016)

Dear Sir or Madam:

Please accept this letter as our nomination of Federal Tracts WY-1302-068 and WY-1302-069 for the BLM next available Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale (August 2, 2016). This acreage was previously nominated by GeoSpectrum, Inc. in our EOI letter (dated March 15, 2012) that resulted in the Bureau of Land Management Decision to defer this land from the February 2013 Preliminary List of competitive oil and gas parcels. The BLM in their letter to us (November 9, 2012) states:

“The following parcels contained contiguous portions in Greater sage-grouse Core Areas that were less than 640 acres in size, and the State Director has exercised his discretion not to offer these parcels to avoid a potential inconsistency with the pending Sage-grouse Resource Management Plan amendments and the State of Wyoming’s Executive Order Number 2011-5 which prescribes a special stipulation to prohibit well pad densities greater than an average of one pad per square mile (640 acres) within Core.”

We anticipate that the recently announced Sage-grouse Resource Management Plan Amendments on May 29, 2015 should be finalized and agreed upon before the nomination period ends for the August 2, 2016 competitive oil and gas lease sale. We trust that the BLM will evaluate and modify our Expression of Interest in this letter or offer us some sort of variance so that our nomination of the above captioned acreage tracts is acceptable to the Sage-grouse Resource Management Plan Amendments for offering in the August 2, 2016 BLM Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale.

We have recently examined ownership records from the Crook County Courthouse in Sundance, Wyoming and Crook County property ownership maps available from the Internet. In our opinion, there have been no significant changes in surface ownership since we nominated the above captioned acreage in our EOI letter of March 15, 2012.
