Re: Protest of Dec 2, 2008 Competitive Oil and Gas Sale



Dear Director Simpson.

We hereby protest the inclusion of the above referenced parcels in the lease sale advertised by the Bureau of Land Management on October 17, 2008. We request the above parcels be withdrawn from sale.

The wild game hunting and fishing on Little Mountain has always been important for our family and we apply for special permits every year. Every year that we have been fortunate to draw a license has been a highlight in our lives for over 50 years. This area is a prime hunting area and should be preserved. We were fortunate to draw elk permits this year and have seen first hand the massive herds of elk that remain in that area. The hunting and fishing are close to our home and is so important to our livelihood. We feel the habitat should be protected for the fish and the wild game. Please do not turn this prime hunting and camping area into another Jonah Field where roads and traffic make the area more like a city and would force the game to move elsewhere. We would appreciate your consideration into our emotions regarding this subject. Please don't let them drill in the Little Mountain area. Thank you.
