Comment:

I support Alternative D of the plan options. I support the Expansion of the Poison Spider Off-Road Park due to the growing need of places to ride ATV's. I support the addition of additional OHV park in the Casper District besides expansion of Poison Spider OHV Park. I support the identification of areas where recreational OHV (ATV, motorcycle, extreme 4 x 4s) use has been occurring and develop plans to designate trails in these areas. I support Adoption of an open unless posted close signage system at start of designation process I support the inventory of roads and trails during travel management planning. I support the adoption of the description of trails, as commonly referenced in state and forest planning, to be 50 inches or less in width. I support not dismissing user created routes during the designation process, a frequently traveled user created route is an indication of a need for a route in the area. I support the allowing of surface disturbances on slopes greater than 25% if engineering can protect the land resource - adoption of this formula would not allow trail building up or down many hills in the plan area.
