## CHANGE:

Two minor changes were made to road designations within The Sand Hills Comprehensive Travel and Transportation Management Area. See Attached Map.

## REASON:

A cut across connecting two designated open routes on the most southeastern portion of the management area was initially designated closed as a duplicate route, has been re-designated as open, because it is not duplicate. The land where the two routes meet is actually private land and cannot be used by the public. In order for the public to use both open routes it was necessary to change the designation on the cut across from closed to open.

A short road in the northeastern part of the plan was initially closed to protect sand dunes and highly erosive soils, has been partly modified. The first part of the road has been changed to allow for authorized use only, while the last part of the road remains closed. This accommodation has been made to allow controlled access into a previously permitted activity associated with a Special Recreation Permit, while still protecting the special resource.
