



CHANGE			
No changes in the wording of Decision 6008 are proposed.			
Map 13 requires revisions to:			
1. Reduce the corridor width from 4 miles wide to 2 miles wide, centered on the 2003 Kern River Pipeline route from the Opal Hub to the Utah state line, and along the Colorado Interstate Gas corridor from Muddy Creek Compressor Station to the Rock Springs Field Office boundary; and			
2. Shift the corridor to the southeast to avoid a tribally sensitive resource, so that the 2003 Kern River Pipeline route is the northwest edge of the corridor in the vicinity of Cumberland Gap (T19N, R116W, Section 32).			
Delete: The 4-mile-wide corridor in the GIS layer for the ROD Map 13.			
Insert: A 2-mile-wide corridor that is centered over the 2003 Kern River Pipeline route, with a shift to the southwest at Cumberland Gap as described above for ROD Map 13.			
REASON			
The change to a 2-mile-wide corridor corrects an error in the GIS layer used in Map 13 in conformance with the language in Decision 6008.			
The shift of the corridor to the southeast at Cumberland Gap avoids a highly sensitive resource to Native American tribes that was identified in 2011 pursuant to the Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act.
