Wild horses and burros were granted protection under the Free-Roaming Wild Horse and Burro Act of 1971, to do anything contrary to their protection is a violation of the will of the people and the federal law. 97 percent of the public land in the planning area is devoted to commercial livestock grazing, while only 25 percent of it is designated as wild horse habitat, which the mustangs must share with livestock. Please ensure that our wild horses get their fair share of our public resources and manage them on the range, allowing these iconic animals to live and die where they were born and where they belong.

You opened this up to comments from the public and I hope that this time you will actually listen to the public who is in out and out disagreement with the way OUR wild horses and burros have been managed over the last several years.
