To whom it may concern,

I am currently leasing four separate grazing permits on the Green Mountain Common Allotment. Under current circumstances the BLM has already cut our permits by 50% and stopped any construction of range improvements. This is a severe hardship to myself and my family. Also, most of the riparian areas that the BLM is concerned about belongs to the State of Wyoming and is none of the BLMs responsibility to manage. We would like to see reasonable grazing seasons and turnout numbers. As things now stand the BLM is taking it upon themselves to manage my entire operation, which without any knowledge of how it works, is a disaster. We make our living on this Allotment and would like to see more cooperation between the BLM and the Permittees on this allotment, as well as, all others managed by the BLM. Early off dates and the severe cut in AUMs is unacceptable.

A BLM employee stated to me in early winter 2011 while conducting thier duties on the Allotment "you guys have a lot of grass left." I think this is a prime example of how detached some in the LFO are from the reality on the ground. Thank you for your time and concideration and we hope that a workable solution may be made for this situation.
