The west side of the Winds have been compromised by run-a-way mineral development. Let us not allow that fate on the east side of the monutains. I would urge you to include all the Wilderness Study Areas and the three CWP's in the planning area as designated wilderness, and ptimum protection for the 9 areas of critical concern.
