



## Public Meetings Scheduled for October 24 - October 28

The Lander Field Office Draft Resource Management Plan (RMP) Revision and Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was released on September 9, 2011. The Lander Field Office will host five public meetings on the Draft RMP and Draft EIS.

Public involvement is an essential and required part of the RMP revision process. These public meetings will provide an opportunity for interested individuals to ask questions, provide input on the draft plan, and help ensure that the BLM is providing a well-balanced plan for the management of public lands in the Lander planning area, which includes portions of Fremont, Sweetwater, Hot Springs, Natrona and Carbon counties.
