2	<p>Dear Ms. Roadifer, I am appalled at the environmental policy of this administration. I support Alternative 3 as the best option that the Bureau of Land Management should consider relative to the future of the Upper Green River Valley. Say no to the development of the oil industry in this area. The Upper Green valley is a national treasure for all people and should not be converted into a private treasure for the supporters of this administration. More oil is not going to make the USA safer; increased oil production is not the best strategy for energy independence. The BLM should consider renewable energy resources instead of destroying it for the short-term interests of the ?oiligarchy? which controls our government during this adminstration. The air over the Upper Green has already been visibly affected by industrial pollution from existing gas rigs. Researchers have noticed significant declines in the mule deer herds and sage grouse populations that winter in the Upper Green. I oppose adding even a single rig. It's a win-win situation: Alternative 3 permits sensible, sustainable development, while simultaneously preserving critical wildlife habitats, unspoiled views, and the unique way of life so many local communities enjoy.
