19	I am in full support of BLM's Preferred Alternative for the Rawlins Resource Management Plan. The Preferred Alternative strikes a key balance between protecting the environment and upholding the mandate of the multiple-use management and the Federal Land Policy and Management Act. The Preferred alternative would allow only 8,822 wells to be drilled over a surface area of 11.2 million acres over the next 15-20 years. The Preferred Alternative will allow one oil or gas well to be drilled per square mile of land. This amounts to a short-term disturbance of only 1.2% of the surface area with long-term disturbance projected to be even less. This will have an extremely minor impact on the land.
