

Criteria for Fire Planning, Fuels Management and Community Assistance State Evaluation Power Point Presentations

We will be looking for an overview of the programs that will be evaluated at the District or Fire Zone level. State Office PPT is optional but if provided should follow the following format:

20-30 minute presentation focusing on program highlights such as:

- Successes-What is working?
- Challenges-What are some barriers to success?
- Overview of organization and relationship to Resource Programs, Management, Fire

Presentation Criteria

a. Program Overview

- i. Program Highlights for each unit (how each office is structured)
 1. District organization and structure (how fuels/fire planning/community assistance staff report to management)
 2. Resource staff (-ologists) who do they work for (FMO or MLR staff) and how are they integrated with Fuels/fire planning/community assistance staff
- ii. Community Assistance
 1. CWPP's how they support and integrate with communities
 2. Highlight main events and larger projects in this Program
 3. Accomplishment Reporting in this Program (spreadsheet)
 4. Prevention/Trespass Plans
- iii. Hazardous Fuels
 1. Prescribed Fire, Mechanical, and Chemical Treatment Success Stories (include partnerships)
 2. Identify Fuels Projects that have reduced the effects of Wildland Fire (FTEM)
 3. Any other noteworthy accomplishments (i.e., Sage-Grouse Habitat projects, Veteran's projects, stewardship contracting, biomass utilization, fuels for schools, etc.)
- iv. Fire Management/Land Use Planning
 1. Highlight accomplishments with R/FMP revisions, status/update of any R/FMP amendments and/or revisions
- v. Vegetative Management Integration with external and internal partners (State, Local, Federal, MLR)
- vi. Data Management (i.e., Great Basin Institute, Range Programs other resources, GIS data layers etc.)
