AK	Egan Cabin	privately-owned with confusing trespass situation that may result in moving structure or quit-claiming it to BLM
	Iditarod NHT Cabins	Not yet sure what's present; will be added to list once assessment has been completed
	Kink Cabin (EAG-00093)	part of the larger Kink Historic Site (EAG-00064) listed on the NRHP in 1975; cabin built around 1903-04. Located at mile 35.7R on the North Fork of the Fortymile W&SR
	Nolan Cabin (Fairbanks)	may need to add to list; cabin located near confluence of Smith & Nolan Creeks about 10 miles NW of Wiseman slightly off the Dalton Highway; in use from the 1920s on; Bob Marshall reputed to have stayed in cabin for a time
	Old Denali Miners Cabin	cabin moved by Cambior deemed NRHP ineligible
	Russian Blockhouse at Sitka, Alaska	In the 1960s, a replica Russian blockhouse was built on a small tract by NPS. Since at least the 1970s, the tract has been under BLM management. The structure is now almost 45 years old and is itself becoming historic, and possibly eligible for the National Register.
	Talkeetna Airstrip	no associated structures
AZ	Empire Ranch	Structures associated with Empire Ranch include Grove House, Field Station, Mechanic's Shop, South Barn, Adobe Barn, and the Stone Corral; also, includes Huachaca House moved from Ft. Huachuca during historic times
	Horsethief Springs Cabin	The cabin dates from ca. 1940, and is constructed of railroad ties, supposedly from the T&T Railroad. There is another structure on the site consisting of a foundation and a partial wall from a turn-of-the-century house.
	Mt. Trumbull Schoolhouse	original schoolhouse was burned down by vandals; current structure is a modern reproduction
	Richardson Homestead (Lake Havasu/Kingman)	never acquired by AZ BLM from ADOT
CA	American Ranch	Within contiguous boundary of Carrizo Plain NM, located on California Department of Fish & Game property
	Burro Schmidt's Tunnel & Cabin	There is a second cabin, built in the 1960s, immediately adjacent Burro Schmidt's Cabin that is not on the National Register and that continues to be a management problem. BLM would like to tear down this second cabin but a public interest group may contest this removal.
	Cache Creek Blue Ridge House and Barn	acquired in 1994; Rock Barn eligible for NRHP, although modifications to house prior to BLM acquisition have likely rendered it ineligible
	Cheese Barn (Coast Dairies) (Hollister)	if this property is ever acquired by BLM, it will need to be added to database
	Deadwood China Camp	no standing structures

	Dottie Wellborn, Great Western, Lost Pony mining districts (Palm Springs)	mining districts not yet adequately inventoried to determine whether standing structures still exist
	Goodwin Ranch House	Within contiguous boundary of Carrizo Plain NM, owned by The Nature Conservancy
	Gus Lederer Site	a prehistoric site with a trail, rock art, etc. but no standing structures Named after "mayor" of Corn Springs, Gus Lederer; Corn Springs is located a mile west of site.
	Horse Thief Springs Cabin	The cabin is on a multi-component site, CA-SBr-2653; cabin dates from ca. 1940 and is constructed of railroad ties, and appears to be eligible as a California Historic Landmark and California Historic Point of Interest. Located just west of the cabin is the partial foundations of the original stone cabin (probably late 19th C). Two of the characters apparently associated with Horse Thief Springs in the late 19th Century are Philander Lee and his brother Leander "Cub" Lee (both important characters in the local and regional history, although neither is associated with 1940s cabin). Philander Lee was the subject of the 13th episode of the 1931 radio show Death Valley Days (later a TV series). The title of the show was "Philander Lee, Squaw Man."
	Jacks Ranger Station (Hollister)	pump shed building, water tank, and associated elements were removed for safety reasons in FY 2007
	Painted Rock Ranch	Within contiguous boundary of Carrizo Plain NM, located on California Department of Fish & Game property
	Picacho Townsite (Hollister)	no standing structures
	Susanville Railroad Depot	privately owned by Lassen Trails & Trust Fund; BLM is a partner
	Walt Bickel Cabin/Camp	structure is part of an active mining claim with about six claimants to the claim, all of whom are members of an active lobbying group that is trying to have Ridgecrest BLM take over protection and management of structure and its surrounding grounds; they are willing to quit claim the camp to BLM, but only if BLM agrees in writing to take over the structure. Cabin is located within the boundary of the Last Chance Canyon Archaeological District but is not part of it.
CO	Bridgeport Station House (Grand Junction)	no standing structures
	Justice Hill Mine	no longer in BLM ownership
	Redvale CCC Camp	Camp has three poured concrete foundations, numerous stone-lined walkways, several symbolic landscape alignments (anchor-shaped sandstone alignments), a concrete loading dock, two standing sandstone hearths/incinerators, and a massive 4-foot tall, arc-shaped sandstone masonry structure of unknown function
ES	Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse	BLM does not manage the lighthouse or its structures, but only the land and natural resources within the ACEC around the lighthouse; the structures have not been relinquished by the Coast Guard
ID	Centerville	no standing structures
	Lava Mining District	are any standing structures here already on list?
	Post Office Complex (Jarbridge)	destroyed in 2007 by 600,000-acre Murphy Fire
	Pulaski Tunnel	no standing structures; consists of trail and actual adit used by fire crews to escape 1910 fire
	Silver City Historic District (Boise)	no BLM owned standing structures
	Thousand Springs Cabin (Challis)	large square-shaped structure that may originally have been a grain storage structure; needs to be added to list

MT	Bryant Mining District	needs to be added to list; includes Hecla Mining District, Canyon Creek Charcoal Kilns, Glendale, Glendale Smelter
	Crichton Mansion (Gage Clark Homestead) (24CH0253/0052)	located on private land
	Pony Historic District	has many standing structures but none are on federal surface
	Powder House	appears to be on private land
	Strawberry Mine	has 5 buildings but Field Office is unsure whether any are on federal surface
	Ward Ranch	maintenance funds being expended in FY 2007 & will be added to list
NV	Bristol Wells Town Site	a small cemetery is all that's on BLM land
	Comstock Cemeteries	As part of the 2001 Save America Treasures grant, three of seven cemeteries have been fenced and maintained; however, most of the cemeteries remain in poor condition
	Historic Railroad Projects (BPS 40207)	are there any standing structures?
	Pony Express Cemetery (Egan) (BPS 43253)	are there any standing structures?
	Rhyolite	includes LV&T RR Depot, Tom Kelly Bottle House, Jail, Small Miner's Cabin (brothel), small wooden bldg near Depot, Cook Bank Building, Porter Brothers Store, School, Overbury Building
	Rock Creek Stage Station, aka Cold Springs Station	there are rock walls, which may be all there ever was; some Pony Express stations were walls without roofs; this is a maintained recreation site
NM	Fort Site	prehistoric (1400s) ancestral Zuni site with walls up to 10 feet in height
	McDonald Memorial Site	located on private land
OR/WA	Allen Gulch Mill (Medford)	only remnants of mill remain; not a complete intact structure
	Allen Gulch Townsite (Medford)	no standing structures
	Frenchglen Guard Station (Burns)	not historic
	Mathew's Guard Station	part of a Forest Service National Register nomination, entitled "USDA Forest Service Administrative Buildings in Oregon and Washington Built by the CCC MPS," that BLM acquired in a 1994/5 land exchange
	Miller Ranch House (Fishtrap Ranch House)	determined NRHP ineligible
	McLoughlin Canyon Historic District	historic landscape with site of 1858 historic battle, historic Cariboo Mining Trail, pictographs, rock features but no standing historic structures
	Rabbit Mine Millhouse (Vale-Baker City)	located at National Historic Oregon Trail Interpretive Site; reconstruction of moved elements determined NRHP ineligible
	Rhododendron Garden (Bend-Myrtlewood)	1912 structure determined NRHP ineligible
	Rich Gulch Mining District	no standing structures
	Rock Corral on the Barlow Road (Salem)	historic archaeological sites with no standing structures
	Sterling Mine Ditch	no standing structures

	Winkle Bar (Medford)	BLM working on acquiring this property located along the Rogue River, site of Zane Grey's cabin and other structures from the 1940s and 1950s
UT	Harrisburg Movie Set (1950s)	used in the Hollywood film entitled "They Came to Cordura" with Gary Cooper, Rita Hayworth, Tab Hunter, Joel McCrae; standing movie set is a plywood and chicken wire/stucco recreation of a small Mexican village in 1905; located within 215-acre tract that came to BLM in 2001 along with Orson Adams House
	Joy Townsite	no standing structures
	Mill Canyon Historic Site (Moab)	Mill Creek is a paleontological site that includes the Halfway Stage Station
	Pahreah Townsite & Spencer's Mining Camp (Kanab)	two different uses of basically the same area; Paria is modern-day spelling of Pahrea
	Silver Reef Heritage Corridor (St. George)	no standing structures except listed Orson Adams House, located ca. 5 miles south of Leeds/Silver Reef; no standing structures at Leeds, Silver Reef or Babylon on public lands
	Simpson Springs Station (Salt Lake)	replica built by Boy Scouts in 1970s
	Topaz War Relocation Center Site (Central Utah Relocation Center)	no standing structures located here
WY	Jelm-Frank Smith Ranch Historic District (Rawlins)	standing structures are located on private land
	Johnston Scout Rocks	should this even be on list?
	Little Mountain Historic Cabins (BPS 41364) (Cody)	are there any standing structures?
	Little Sandy Stage Station (Rock Springs)	no standing structures
	South Pass City (Lander)	part of the town located on BLM land, but area is leased to State who covers all management; BLM is in the process of transferring property to State but this could take several years to complete; thus, reconstructed historical buildings are located on BLM land
	Tom Sun Ranch (Lander)	part of this NHL is on BLM land but all standing structures are on private land
