



Black Canyon National Recreation Trail



The Black Canyon National Recreation Trail (BCT) is a 79-mile hiking, mountain biking and equestrian trail stretching from the Sonoran Desert lowlands in Phoenix to the high grasslands of Prescott Valley.

The project will create jobs for private trail contractors and youth corps crews as they restore existing and build new trail. The project involves 35-miles of new construction and trail maintenance.

Repairs will consist of tread restoration; refurbishing water management structures (water bars, dips, drains, steps, and wash crossings); renovating switchbacks; and brushing intruding vegetation. The balance of the project involves new or extensively re-aligned trail construction, utilizing experienced private trail contractors.
