Attached is a California Desert District map that may be of use to you, regarding the 'green line.' Also, if you use google earth at all, it has "PLSS" feature/layer (Public Land Survey System). Plot the same line in google earth, and the PLSS would allow use of the Master Title Plats (official land status records) in determining ownership more specifically - and would allow for a legal description (townships, ranges, and sections) of said line to help answer your question.
